

Election results – Shift in Germantown Politics

On November 6, 2007, Germantown voters made a significant change. For the first time in recent memory, the Democratic Party picked up a seat on the Town Council when Democratic candidate Jerry Smith out polled incumbent Anthony Cidras. Incumbent Graceann Lamberta was reelected. Arthur Schiff, running as a registered Democrat on the Democratic line polled 326 votes. Joel Craig, a registered Republican ran on the Democratic and Republican lines. The Democratic Craig whipped the Republican Craig by a whopping vote of 397 to 302. In fact a total of 1,099 votes were cast on the Democratic line as against 1,049 on the combined Republican, Conservative and Community Unity lines. Results of the election are in the chart.
